This course will develop competencies and proficiency in fundamental computer skills. Students will learn to use a computer as a personal and business tool. This course will introduce you to the power of Microsoft Office which includes four major applications: Word, Excel, Access and PowerPoint. The introduction of this software will involve word processing, spreadsheets, database entry and presentations. Students will learn the necessary skills needed to use a personal computer throughout their high school career and beyond. **This course is required for students in grade 9.**
