About Minithon:

Minithon originated with Thon, a student run organization based out of Penn State University, where students stand/dance/play games for 46 hours straight. The key thing is that no one can sit down for the duration of the event. All of the fundraising leading up to the event goes towards the **Four Diamonds** organization, which funds cancer research and support for families with children who have the horrible disease.

Many high schools, including ours and many in our area, have developed **Minithon**, where students stand for 8 hours.

Preparation:

Preparation and fundraising for the big event takes the entire year, and we are split into 8 committees: Fundraising, Finance, Operations, Hospitality, Entertainment, Family Relations, Advertising, and Morale.

Notable Events From This Year:

This year, we have hosted fundraisers such as the **Superhero 5K** in the fall, our **Kids Night Out** hosted at the high school, and our **Harlem Wizards** game also hosted at the high school.

How you can get involved/Community Hour:

On the night of Minithon itself, we hold a **Community Hour**, which is a two hour window (**6-8**) in which community members can come into the high school at any point and are given a tour of the event. It is a good way to check out what your community's school has been up to, to show your upcoming high school students a sneak peak of the high school and its activities, as well as a good way to support Minithon!!!
