HEALTH AND FCS ACCELERATION INFORMATION**

**\*Only current high school students may accelerate\***

**\*Acceleration is not available for current 8<sup>th</sup> grade students\***

Information about Methacton's on-line summer school Health and FCS classes:

- Courses are provided through Brandywine Virtual Academy (BVA)
- Health and FCS through BVA are each .5 credits
- Each course is \$299. Payment is due in full at the time of registration.
- To register for Health or FCS, please navigate to the high school website and click on the summer school "RegWerks" link. Registration is capped at 60 students for Health and 30 students for FCS. Registration is first-come, first-served (on-line only).
- Acceleration forms are not needed for Health and FCS
- Registration for **rising seniors** needing FCS and Health will begin April 3, 2017
- All other registration will begin April 10, 2017
- The deadline for registration is May 1, 2017
- Students have the option of reporting to the high school library to work on their courses Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 8am-12pm for the length of the course. Teachers will be available for assistance.
- Estimated time to complete a .5 credit acceleration course is 60 hours
- We will offer an optional (but strongly suggested) orientation to the on-line program at the beginning of the summer, date TBD
- Courses run June 19 through July 27. There are no extensions under any circumstances.
- If either course has a final, students will have to report to the high school library on or before July 27<sup>th</sup> to take the final in the library. Students must arrange the date in advance with Ms. Olitsky, the Summer School Coordinator.
- All expenses are the responsibility of the student.
