

CAR DROP- OFF and PICK-UP: VISITOR PARKING

Students being dropped off for school will be let out only in the car loop to the right of the parking lot. Parents will pull around the loop and drop-off their children and stay in the car to keep the flow of traffic moving. If a parent has reason to enter the school building, he or she must drop off his or her child first and then park and enter the building.

Pick-up will take place in the same car loop. Parents may stage along the curb of the loop across the front of the school building awaiting dismissal. Again, parents should stay in their cars and await their child's dismissal from the car line. Students are not permitted to cross over the car line to get to the parking lot.

A small number of visitor parking spaces are located in the front of the building, on the left as you come to the top of the driveway. Additional parking is found in the large parking area to the right of the drive.
