In addition, parents have the opportunity to attend student and parent programs, as well as individual conferences at different times during the school year. They will be encouraged to submit any questions or comments regarding the policy and the Title I program. This compact was reviewed, planned and agreed upon with parents.

Parents are invited to observe classes during American Education Week and to attend a parent teacher conference to review the child's needs and goals and learn about the curriculum and academic standards. In addition to receiving instructional support, Title I students also receive supplementary reading and math materials, including Reading Connection and Math Connection newsletters.
