- ii. Audit of compliance of Special Education Plan by the State
  - 1. There will be a survey to sent to parents
- iii. Update on Inclusive Practices model Dr. Fowlston
  - 1. What supports and services we have at Skyview

The district will need to do a comprehensive plan this year

1. Our new admin will contact us around March to provide

- a. Dr. Fowlston handed out a chart with the supports and services and the person in each area (see attached)
- b. A Special Education teacher is in each homeroom team for 5<sup>th</sup> grade and follows the class throughout the day.
- c. The counselor moves up to the  $6^{th}$  grade with the  $5^{th}$  grade class

- d. Services are done during Hawk Huddle and Flex time so the kids can stay with the general ed class as much as possible
  - i. Flex day is opposite gym day
- e. There is only 4 teams with a Special Education teacher that is designated and one team doesn't have one for 6<sup>th</sup> grade
- 2. Arcola has only 3 teams and has a Special Education teacher for each team.
  - a. The counselors travel with their grade up to 8<sup>th</sup> grade
  - b. Designated emotional support teacher at Arcola
    - i. No tier support at Arcola
  - c. Designated life skills teacher at Arcola
  - d. Arcola has learning support classes

### 3. Programs

- a. How to include students more than a general education setting. 5<sup>th</sup> grade is mostly in the general education classroom and supported by instructional assistants.
  - i. Work with Lauren Benfield to meet with teachers to help them with inclusion. She worked with the 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers as a team and also with individual teachers.
  - ii. Make sure the students can access something similar even if they are not on the grade level learning
  - iii. In December Lauren Benfield will come out and work with the teachers according to subjects
  - iv. In the Spring she will meet with 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers to prepare them
- b. What is appropriate school behavior, Positive Behavior Intervention Systems
  - i. Training through the MCIU
  - There are team members from each area of the school developing PBIS and learning from the MCIU
  - iii. Reinforce the positive behaviors

- iv. Setting expectations on what behavior should look like in different areas
- v. Setting a standard for the culture and environment of the school
- vi. How does your behavior affect others
- vii. What is an appropriate consequence
- viii. Follow the Methacton Code of Conduct
- ix. Provide support to teachers also how to respond to the behavior and allows it to be consistent throughout all teachers
- x. Everyone in the entire school is invited to the training for PBIS
- 4. Transition from elementary school
  - a. They talk with the principals, meet with the teachers and then present to the 4<sup>th</sup> grade students.
  - b. The 4<sup>th</sup> grade students also are invited to tour Skyview
  - c. The 4<sup>th</sup> grade case managers meet with the 5<sup>th</sup> grade case managers in the summer to discuss the students and transition
  - d. The first part of school, the homerooms have team building exercises to make students feel comfortable.
- 5. Transition to 6<sup>th</sup> grade
  - a. The 5<sup>th</sup> grade case managers meet with the 6<sup>th</sup> grade case manager
- 6. Transition to Arcola
  - a. Similar transition process as from the transition from elementary to Skyview
- 7. Transition to High School
  - a. They have an orientation before the start of the school vear
- 8. Special Olympics
  - a. Springford is hosting for the second year
  - b. Dr. Fowlston is organizing the Special Olympics, instead of the teachers organizing
  - c. This years date May 1, 2024
  - d. Registration has already started
- 9. Skyview and Arcola have a Buddies program
