E-Sports



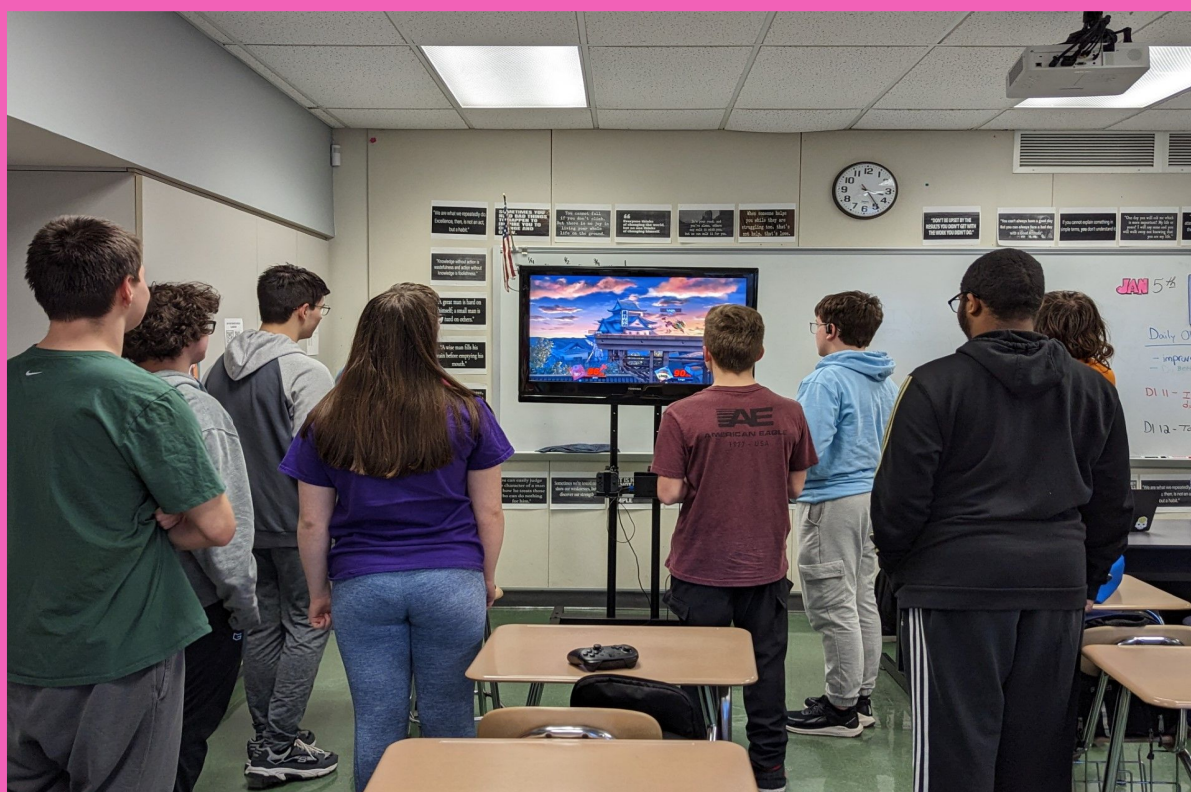
A form of competition using video games. E-Sports often takes the form of organized, multiplayer video game competitions, particularly between professional players, individually or as teams.
