

Demolition

- Bursich prepared drawing showing the final conditions of the Audubon ES property after demolition of the building and the site.
 - The building will be completely removed and the former footprint regraded.
 - The driveways and parking on the west side of the property, as well as the rear parking lot are retained.
 - The parking lot on the east side of the property is retained as well, along with a pathway to the playground.









Future Property Considerations

- How can we leverage the property for district use:
 - Location of a future school if needed
 - No plans for next 10 years for need (based on enrollment projections)
 - Athletic facilities
 - Provide track/field facilities for Arcola/High School student use
 - Provide Arcola/SV parking/campus congestion relief
 - District busing terminal
 - Provide high school student/staff/visitor parking relief
 - Provide high school campus safety

NOTE: Each one of these ideas can be co-located with other community recreational amenities.

Projected Costs

- Location of a future school if needed
 - \$50 \$70 million
- Athletic facilities
 - Provide track/field facilities for Arcola/High School student use
 - \$5 \$7 million
 - Provide Arcola/SV parking/campus congestion relief
 - TBD
- District busing terminal
 - Provide high school student/staff/visitor parking relief
 - Provide high school campus safety
 - Annual increase in transportation costs \$300K \$400K
 - Construction of site \$5 \$7 million

- Share current status with Board
