











The results are in!

Our Journey

2021-2022

- Committee selected Into Math & iReady as possible programs.
- Pilot teachers were identified and provided materials and training.

SUMMER 2022

- Pacing Charts were created to match current scope & sequence.
- Unit Zero resources were built to close skill gaps and prepare students for new learning

FALL 2022

- Pilot teachers worked hard to learn both resources and shift their instructional model.
- Support was given through coaching, site visits, and trainings.

WINTER 2023

 February 1st the pilot group unanimously chose iReady Math to recommend as the program to support our district math goals






