Purpose of the Boost Program

- **Methacton Boost** is an after-school program that offers additional scaffolded supports to eligible students. The Boost program will provide opportunities for students to receive evidence-based, targeted instruction in key content areas (reading and mathematics) to accelerate their learning and help to close achievement gaps.
- **Student Participation:** Students will be invited based on district benchmark data.



Boost Curriculum

➤ English Language Arts-

- Grouping students using benchmark and formative data
- Small group instruction will be based on the “I Can” statements in order to target grade level skills that need to be practiced
- Lexia Core5 Computer Based Intervention-Research based program that automatically places students on a prescribed practice path

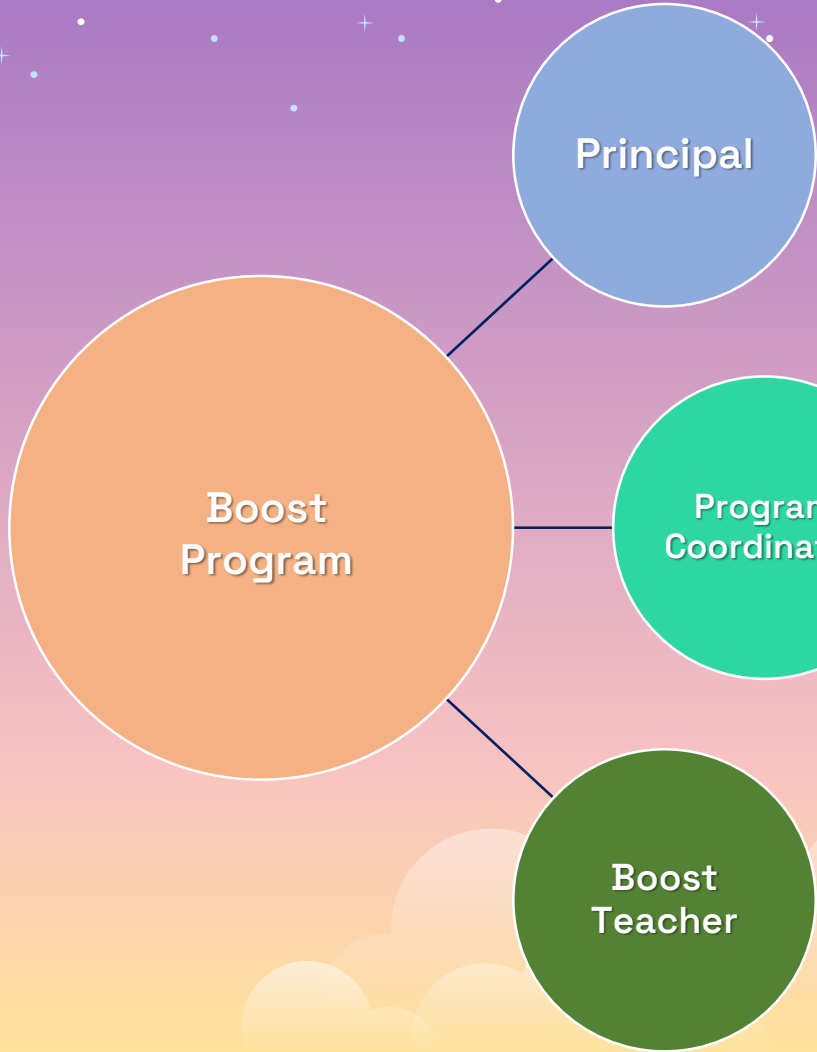
➤ Mathematics-

- Grouping students using benchmark and formative data
- Small group instruction will be based on the “I Can” statements in order to target grade level skills that need to be practiced
- Reflex Math-Research based program provides students practice based on targeted math skills

➤ Progress Monitoring-

- Lexia Core5 and Reflex Math provide individualized progress monitoring tools
- District benchmarks
