Purpose of the Boost Program

- **Methacton Boost is an after-school program that offers** additional scaffolded supports to eligible students. The Boost program will provide opportunities for students to receive evidence-based, targeted instruction in key content areas (reading and mathematics) to accelerate their learning and help to close achievement gaps.
- **Student Participation:** Students will be invited based on district benchmark data.



Boost Enrollment ELA (Reading) and Mathematics

| Grade Level | ELA (Reading) | Mathematics |
|---------------------------------|----------------------|--------------------|
| Grade 1 | 48 | 23 |
| Grade 2 | 33 | 23 |
| Grade 3 | 38 | 32 |
| Grade 4 | 32 | 36 |
| Total Number of Students | 151 | 114 |



Boost ELA and Math Mid-Year Summary Data

➤ **Summary of ELA Data:**

- ▶ On average, Boost students grew $\frac{1}{2}$ level MORE on mid-year Fountas and Pinnell benchmark testing compared to their tier 2 and 3 Non-Boost peers.

➤ **Summary of Math Data:**

- ▶ On average, Boost students grew 10% MORE on the mid-year Linkit Benchmark than their tier 2 and 3 Non-Boost peers.
- ▶ Participation in the Boost Program has been flexible based on mid-year benchmark data at each school.



Boost Moving Forward towards the April 5th Conclusion

- Training for administrators and Boost teachers revealed students would benefit even more they were on Lexia for 60 minutes a week.
- Principals and Boost teachers are encouraging classroom teachers and parents to get students on Lexia more during the week.
- Principals have recently “graduated” and added students to Boost based on data collected from mid-year benchmarks.
- Principals will collect data on the Boost students again at the end of the year.
- Each school will hold a year end celebration party for Boost students in order to recognize their commitment and hard work.
