RATIONALE:

- Improves access to mental health services in the home school
- Supports increase in mental health needs (Anxiety, Depression, Trauma, Suicide Ideation, Eating Disorders)
- Provides early intervention & treatment
- Reduces stigma associated with mental health disorders

R.E.A.C.H. PROVIDES:

ACCESS to a therapeutic level of care for students within their home school

Daily group therapy and individual counseling

Collaboration with families, school professionals, outside medical & mental health providers (Continuity of Care)

Telephone access for after-hour support – 24/7 crisis services

Family therapy (as needed/requested)

Ongoing support, consultation and professional development for staff
