# *Kindergarten Ready!*

<b>Description</b>	Introduce incoming Kindergarten students to procedures, routines, building relationships, tour of school, and an overview of basic early learning skills
<b>Skills</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Kindergarten procedures and routines</li><li>• Introduction of early literacy and foundational skills</li><li>• Social and emotional connections with peer groups</li></ul>
<b>Students</b>	All registered, incoming Kindergarten students
<b>Location</b>	All Four Elementary Schools (Arrowhead, Eagleville, Worcester, and Woodland)
<b>Dates and Times</b>	Session One: August 10, 11 (9:00-11:30 AM Class); (12:30-3:00 PM Class) Session Two: August 17, 18 (9:00-11:30 AM Class); (12:30-3:00 PM Class)

# K-6 Intervention Program

<b>Description</b>	Reinforce and strengthen foundational skills and math fact fluency and computation in Grades K-6. Students identified by each school team based on eligibility and need.
<b>Skills</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension in literacy</li><li>• Fact fluency, computation, and numbers sense in math</li><li>• Individual and small group instruction</li></ul>
<b>Students</b>	Identified current K-6 students
<b>Location</b>	Online and Skyview Elementary
<b>Dates and Times</b>	4 weeks, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, 9:00-12:00 July 6-July 29
<b>Transportation</b>	Busing provided by district (details TBA) Parent drop-off and pick-up available
<b>Staffing</b>	14 teachers, 1 Summer Coordinator
<b>Cost</b>	No cost to families Funded by district and grant monies (approx. \$24,500)

# K-6 Supplemental Program

<b>Description</b>	Supplemental learning in reading and math to reinforce and strengthen foundational skills and/or math fact fluency and computation in Grades K-6.
<b>Skills</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension in literacy</li><li>• Fact fluency, computation, and numbers sense in math</li></ul>
<b>Students</b>	All current K-6 students
<b>Location</b>	Online Programs
<b>Dates and Times</b>	Flexible, asynchronous, self-paced
<b>Transportation</b>	N/A

<b>Students</b>	All current Grades 7-12 students
<b>Location</b>	Online
<b>Dates and Times</b>	8 weeks (flexible), asynchronous, self-paced, June 28- August 20
<b>Transportation</b>	N/A
