 2013-2014 SPPs available in Fall 2014
 - Achievement Gap Data will be a part of the 2013-2014 profile
- Teacher Specific Data → PA Value Added Assessment System (PVAAS)
 - Based on PSSA/Keystone scores
 - Will be applied to teachers who teach children taking PSSA or Keystone Exams

Elective Data → Student Learning Objectives (SLOs)

- Counts for all teaching professionals
- Intermediate Units are in the process of providing information from PDE to districts

Observation/Evidence

- Methacton administrators have been observing instructional practices and collecting evidence through:
 - formal classroom observations
 - informal classroom observations
 - the district's newly-implemented differentiated supervision model.
- All data collected is aligned with the Danielson Framework for Teaching Practices.
